

Strategic Partnership Program: Terms & Conditions - EIG

These Terms and Conditions ("Agreement") govern the relationship between Enrichers Investment Group (the "Company") and the Strategic Partner (SP). By registering through the Company's digital portal and ticking the "Accept Terms" box, the SP agrees to be bound by the provisions outlined herein.

1. About the Company

Enrichers Investment Group is a leading investment company established in 2011, with a strong presence in Pakistan's financial markets and investment ecosystem.

The Company operates in:

- Financial Markets Trading
- Physical Trading
- Agriculture (Conventional & Mudarabah structures)
- Real Estate (including REIT-related services)

Through its regulated subsidiaries:

- Enrichers Securities Private Limited (TREC Holder – PSX, regulated by SECP)
- Enrichers Private Limited (TREC Holder – PMEX, regulated by SECP)

2. Role of Strategic Partner (SP)

The SP acts as an independent business introducer responsible for identifying, referring, and introducing potential clients ("Investors") to the Company.

The SP:

- Does not act as an employee, agent, franchisee, or legal representative of the Company
- Does not have the authority to bind the Company in any agreement
- Operates strictly as an independent referral partner

3. Scope of Engagement

3.1 Company Responsibilities

The Company shall:

- Provide SP with accurate information regarding investment services
- Support investor onboarding and presentations where required
- Execute all formal client agreements directly with investors

3.2 SP Responsibilities

The SP shall:

- Use their professional network to introduce potential investors/clients
- Facilitate initial communication between investors/clients and the Company
- Provide general coordination support where required
- Ensure ethical conduct and compliance with applicable laws
- Avoid making misleading or unauthorized claims about the Company

4. Compensation & Revenue Sharing

4.1 SP Commission

The SP shall be entitled to receive **20% (twenty percent) of the brokerage revenue** earned by the Company from each successfully onboarded and active client referred by the SP.

4.2 Ongoing Revenue Share

The SP shall continue to receive revenue share for as long as the referred client remains active with the Company, unless otherwise terminated under these Terms.

4.3 Other Investment Products

For investment products beyond brokerage services (including Agriculture, REITs, Real Estate, Mudarabah), compensation will be defined separately on a case-by-case basis.

4.4 Sub-Strategic Partners (Sub-SPs)

The SP may introduce additional Sub-SPs to the Company.

- A Sub-SP shall receive 15% revenue share from clients introduced by them
- The SP shall also receive 10% revenue share from such clients
- The structure may be updated or reviewed by the Company from time to time

4.5 Payment Timeline

All eligible revenue shares shall be processed and paid within 10 working days after the end of each calendar month.

5. Independent Relationship

The SP is an independent contractor. The SP shall be solely responsible for all taxes, filings, and personal obligations arising from earnings.

Nothing in these Terms shall be interpreted to create:

- Employment relationship
- Partnership
- Joint venture
- Franchise
- Agency

6. Branding & Representation Restrictions

The SP shall NOT:

- Use the Company's name, logo, branding, or trademarks for marketing
- Represent themselves as an official agent, franchise, or branch
- Create misleading impressions of authority or ownership

Any violation shall be treated as a **material breach**, resulting in:

- Immediate termination
- Suspension of payments
- Legal action, where applicable

7. Confidentiality

The SP agrees to maintain strict confidentiality regarding:

- Client information
- Business processes
- Internal strategies
- Financial arrangements

No disclosure shall be made to any third party without prior written consent.

8. Compliance with Laws

The SP agrees to comply with all applicable:

- SECP regulations
- Financial market rules
- Anti-money laundering (AML) requirements
- Applicable laws of Pakistan

9. Term & Termination

These Terms remain effective from the date of acceptance via website form submission.

The Company reserves the right to:

- Suspend or terminate SP participation at any time in case of breach
- Terminate without notice in case of fraud, misrepresentation, or misconduct

10. Governing Law

These Terms shall be governed and interpreted under the laws of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

11. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute shall be resolved through binding arbitration in Pakistan, in accordance with applicable arbitration laws.

12. Entire Understanding

These Terms represent the complete understanding between the Company and SP and supersede any prior communication or arrangement.
